Position: Youth Pastor

Job Description: Youth Pastor is responsible for casting vision, clarifying mission, developing strategies, and maintaining a culture that fosters spiritual growth by building strong disciples among middle school and high school students.

Building Strong Disciples:

- Build and invest in a strong youth leadership team that strategically makes disciples out of students.
- Continued relationship building with leaders and students via local Fellowship of Christian Athlete groups and other campus outreach opportunities.
- Speak into and help in the overall discipleship pathway and approach for the church as a whole. This involves working closely with lead pastor, pastors, and other staff.

Casting Vision:

- Prepare and schedule the themes and overall direction of the Youth Group.
- Plan speaking schedule, worship schedule (partnering with worship pastor), games, and events in advance.
- Communicate with the youth leadership team on a weekly basis.
- Provide ways for the youth leadership team to get together and grow as a team and as disciples.
- Constantly look for new leaders in the church who could be a part of the growing Youth Group team.

Weekly Responsibilities:

- Prepare weekly sermons, youth leaders or a guest speaker to speak.
- Have small group questions from the Sunday sermon prepared each week for small groups on Sunday Nights to help direct conversation.
- Execute Youth Group games (plan, lead, or delegate).
- Meet with students regularly (Coffee, Bible Study). Empower the leadership team to lead Bible studies and meet with students as necessary.
- Prep for future sermons (Youth Group/Sunday Mornings).
- Set up the Community Center each week for Youth Group.
- Meet with church interns, provide them with challenging assignments and let them lead in areas they are passionate about.
- Attend staff meetings.

Annual & Unique Projects:

- Mobilize students in both local & global outreach (annual mission trip).
- Promote Summer Camps and encourage enrollment.
