

Information about New Life Fellowship church and Jason & Angie's roles:

Their church has about 2,500 people in the capital city of Phnom Penh, with another 250 churches in the villages and cities across Cambodia. New Life is also on track to have 500 churches across Cambodia by the year 2020. It's a very exciting time and people are coming to know Christ and are being set free every week.

Angie is the worship pastor and advisor to the overseer of our weekend services and events, and she cares for our Phnom Penh worship team (120 people) that serve at our two campuses for 7 services every weekend, plus conferences and events. She also oversees our songwriting team and recording projects. Our team has produced 5 live worship albums since 2013. Angie also facilitates fundraising for the worship ministry and teaches in our church's School of Worship.

Jason and Angie serve as elders in the church. Jason is the advisor to all of our regional pastors in Phnom Penh and our pastoral care ministry. He also works closely with the senior pastor in several various projects, preaches occasionally, and teaches regularly in New Life's internship program.

Job Description Overview:

Jason & Angie Prosser are looking for someone that can be a support to Angie as she homeschools two of their three kids, Justus (age 12) and Emma (age 11-at the beginning of next school year).

Angie will make the curriculum decisions, assign weekly goals, and teach on Mondays. The support teacher will follow through with the weekly plan, do a minimal amount of lesson planning, and will teach Tuesdays through Fridays (8:00am until noon).

Current curriculum:

Math: Teaching Textbooks - this is an online class that teaches the concepts, and scores their work. Very little assistance is required with this subject, but no lesson planning.

Etymology/Spelling: ACE Word Building PACEs - the PACE provides the instruction, the kids do their work by hand, and the teacher uses a score key to mark what is incorrect and they correct it before moving on. Some assistance is required with this subject, but no lesson planning.

English Grammar: ACE Word Building PACEs - the PACE provides the instruction, the kids do their work by hand, and the teacher uses a score key to mark what is incorrect and they correct it before moving on. Some assistance is required with this subject, but no lesson planning.

The have been using Classical Conversations for Science, History and Geography over the past few years. Angie will be looking into either the next level of CC or other curriculums for these subjects for 2019-2020.

We have also used IEW's Ancient History-Based Writing Lessons for this past year for Creative Writing, but will most likely not continue with that next year. Justus and Emma are currently in a homeschool co-op (that Angie helps teach and coordinate) on Tuesdays from mid-morning through the afternoon. For the Fall 2019 term, they will do creative writing, math-science projects, and either choir or art.

Financial Cost & Provision:

Over the past few years, God has provided financial support for their kids' educational needs, and the Prosser's have budgeted to pay the support teacher \$15 a day.

For budgeting to live in Phnom Penh, they may be able to work on finding low-cost housing close to their home and the church. Their house is also a 15-minute walk from the church and grocery store. The support teacher would also be welcome to eat lunch with us Monday through Friday, and possibly dinners at times if need be.

They will also try to get an estimate from a couple of other missionaries that are living in Phnom Penh and serving at New Life Fellowship church, to give a ballpark estimate on monthly living expenses. However, a lot depends on each person's individual needs & wants in terms of their style of living.

We usually finish up Justus & Emma's work by lunch time or shortly after. This means the support teacher would have afternoons and evenings to serve in another area of New Life.

New Life has a lot of various ministries and has relationship/partnership with many more around the city.

If there is interest in helping in worship ministry, we have admin tasks that need to be done weekly. Depending on skill set, support teacher could also potentially assistant teach in our School of Worship, but language is a bit of a barrier as most of our students don't speak English.

There is also an option to help with our Skills Training Center, they always need English teachers and/or conversation buddies. Most of our English students are 16-22 years old, and love meeting "foreigners" that can help them practice their English.

If the support teacher would like to get out in the villages, there are opportunities with the church planting ministry. They might need help with field visits, taking photos, and writing newsletters in English etc.

The Healing Home ministry is geared towards those that either want to have a career in the medical field or have a heart and gift to care for and pray for the sick. We've seen many people receive healing, peace and salvation through this ministry. The nursing staff there will often spend hours worshipping quietly and praying over the patients while attending to their needs so this could also be an option.

If there is interest in helping with children's ministry, or admin, the team is always in need of more hands for various projects.
