Every Other Year Courses to be offered Fall 2019

Juniors and Seniors, if any of these courses are required under your track please take the course this semester. It will not be offered again until Fall 2021.

Wisdom Literature - Bi 415

Ken Malmin, 3 Credits

King Solomon declares that wisdom is worth more than any monetary value. The pursuit of wisdom is one of the greatest keys of life. This course explores Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and the Song of Solomon with an emphasis on the understanding and the pursuit of wisdom. The study of the distinct literary forms of these books in their biblical context is combined with personal and practical application for a dynamic look of the biblical Wisdom Literature.

Minor Prophets - Bi 423

Travis Arnold, 2 Credits

An analysis of biblical prophecies as expressed in the Minor Prophets considering both natural and historical significance and their relevance today. Special attention is given to Messianic prophecies involving Christ and the Church, prophetic ministry, and the personal application of their timeless truths.

Course that will be offered Fall 2020

Important Information: MUSIC STUDENTS

General (Music-Related):

- All PBC students are eligible to take private lessons as either required or elective courses. Once you select and register for a private lesson course in Populi, the Mannahouse Music School office will contact you in order to view and select potential teacher and lesson times for the upcoming semester.
